Incentives

Story City Economic Development Corporation works closely with the State of Iowa and City of Story City to design a complete and competitive package of incentives to suit the development needs for a qualified prospect. Incentives may include:

Site Grant: For new construction, development site at no cost.

Tax Abatement: For new construction, the City of Story City five years declining tax abatement, beginning at 75%, decreasing 15% each year.

Economic Grant: City of Story City will consider an economic grant based on needs of a qualified prospect.

Economic Loan: City of Story City will consider an economic loan of up to \$50,000.

State of lowa: A number of grants and loans are available through the State of lowa. The City of Story City will provide a grant application assistance at no cost.





Available Land

Story City has always been aggressive when it comes to developing and expanding land for industry. The opportunity to own a very competitively priced, shovel-ready lot located within a tax-increment area complete with water, sewer, power and telecommunications infrastructure in place is here in Story City.
